For the reasons described in court on March 13, 2003, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The government and the direct defendants shall confer and, by March 20, 2003, report on the status of their settlement discussions.

2. The government and the direct defendants shall, by April 4, 2003, file cross-motions for summary judgment, in the form required by Local Rule 56.1, if there is a proper basis to do so, on the plaintiff's claims under the Federal Debt Collection Act and the False Claims Act relating to mailings associated with: (a) Catholic Daughters of the Americas; (b) Fleet Reserve Association; (c) Moose International; and (d) Shriner's Hospital for Children. Replies shall be filed by April 18, 2003.

3. A hearing on the anticipated cross-motions for summary judgment will be held on May 5, 2003, at 3:00 p.m. The third party

For the reasons described in court on March 13, 2003, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The government and the direct defendants shall confer with the undersigned by March 20, 2003, report on the status of their settlement discussions.

2. The government and the direct defendants shall, by April 5, 2003, file cross-motions for summary judgment. In the event that the government fails to file a proper motion to do so, the court shall grant summary judgment to the direct defendants on the plaintiff's claims under the Federal Debt Collection Act and the Fair Labor Standards Act relating to (a) the plaintiff's claims for unpaid wages and (b) the plaintiff's claims for unpaid overtime pay. The government's motion for summary judgment shall be filed by April 14, 2003.
